

5 REASONS TO OPPOSE SCHOOL VOUCHERS

Lack of Accountability

Private schools that accept vouchers are often not held to the same accountability standards as public schools, which could lead to an inadequate education for students with disabilities.



Limited Options

Many private schools are not equipped to provide the specialized services and accommodations that students with disabilities require, leaving families with limited options.



Less Funding for Public Schools

School vouchers divert funding away from public schools, potentially leaving them with less resources to support students with disabilities.



Increased Segregation

School vouchers can lead to increased segregation, as private schools may not have the same diversity as public schools.
