QUALITY OF LIFE

When Texans with IDD receive individualized supports and services, they're able to make their own decisions about how and where they want to live and work.



INCLUSIVE EDUCATION

Inclusive education policies are necessary to assist Texans with IDD in reaching their full potential – from early childcare settings to postsecondary education.



CIVIL RIGHTS & JUSTICE

When Texans with IDD have equitable access to justice and services within community, they are less likely to be victims of abuse and crime, and more likely to participate civically.



INTEGRATED EMPLOYMENT

Work is fundamental to adult life, and Texans with IDD have skills the workforce needs. Policies are needed to improve competitive, integrated employment options.

WHAT IS IDD?

Intellectual and Developmental Disability

INTELLECTUAL DISABILITY

Occurs before age 18.

Characterized by significant limitations in both intellectual functioning and adaptive behavior, such as social and practical everyday living skills.

DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITY

Severe chronic disability attributable to a mental or physical impairment, or combination. Manifests before age 22. Examples: autism spectrum disorder, cerebral palsy, and Down syndrome.
